### **Louis Dornier et Fils Brut**

*Champagne, France, 12%*

A light, fresh, vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long, crisp palate **39.95**

### **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut**

*Champagne, France, 12%*

Intense floral and fruity aromas with a musky tinge and lingering apple and pear notes **65.95**

### **Special Cuvée Bollinger**

*Champagne, France, 12%*

Rich, toasty and full bodied with wonderful concentration of depth and flavour **66.95**

### **Cuvée Dom Perignon Moët et Chandon 2004**

*Champagne, France, 12.5%*

Aromas of acacia honey and fresh almonds, dried apricots and toasted brioche **149.95**

### **Cuvée Rosé Brut Laurent Perrier**

*Champagne, France, 12%*

Elegant with soft bubbles, ripe red fruits and a soft creamy finish **79.95**

### **Los Romeros Merlot Rosé 2016**

(House wine)

*Central Valley, Chile, 13%*

Bright raspberry and strawberry aromas with pleasant blackcurrant flavours make this a soft easy drinking wine **4.00 / 5.40 / 15.95**

### **Short Mile Bay Rosé 2015**

*South Eastern Australia, 12%*

A fresh and fruity rosé made from the Cabernet Sauvignon grape; shows notes of strawberry and red cherry backed by citrus **4.50 / 6.00 / 17.95**

### **Greenwood Pass White Zinfandel**

**2015, California, USA, 10.5%**

Mouthwatering watermelon, strawberry and cherry flavours, with an accent of citrus on the finish **4.80 / 6.50 / 18.95**

### **Anjou Rosé, Château de Fesles 2015**

*Loire Valley, France, 11.5%*

Dark pink with violet reflections; generous bouquet with ripe strawberry, plum and hints of spice. Off-dry, well-balanced, with plenty of red and dark fruit flavours. Made predominantly from the Grolleau variety grown on old vines near the centre of the Anjou region **23.95**

### **Floralis Moscatel Oro Catalunya, Torres**

*Catalunya, Spain, 15%*

Trademark Moscatel aromas of orange blossom, Turkish delight and honeyed fruit, accompanied by delicious spicy notes. Indulgently sweet, with an enduring candied finish

### **Gonzalez Byass Noe, Pedro Ximénez Muy Viejo (30)**

*Andalucía, Spain, 15.5%*

One of the world's oldest and rarest dessert wines with a powerful bouquet, oozing heady aromas of concentrated raisin, fig, coffee and Christmas spices finished with a taste of sweet, plump, cooked fruit

### **Dow's Quinta do Bomfim, Vintage**

**Port 2005**

*Douro, Portugal, 20%*

Excellent aromas of black berry fruits, combined with a hint of violet character. Packed with juicy fruit flavours, peppery tannins, and a long slightly dry finish

### Crisp, dry wines

**Borsari Inzolia, Terre Siciliane 2015** (House wine)  
*Sicilia, Italy, 12%*

The Inzolia grape is indigenous to Sicily where it produces a delicious, light herbal and lemon aroma with a warm peachy flavour

**Antonio Rubini Pinot Grigio delle Venezie 2016**  
*Veneto, Italy, 11.5%*

The Pinot Grigio grapes used to make this wine were grown in the Pavia region, not far from Milan. Shows apple and pear with hints of white peach and elderflower

**Petit Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils 2015**

*Burgundy, France, 12%*

From the outlying parts of the Chablis region comes this dry, steely white wine, similar in style to its more famous big brother only a little lighter

*Piemonte, Italy, 13%*

This excellent producer crafts this refreshing gooseberry and mineral style with delicate floral hints

### Aromatic, dry wines

**Los Romeros Sauvignon Blanc 2016**

*Central Valley, Chile, 12.5%*

As an everyday drinking Sauvignon Blanc, this wine represents excellent value. Aromas of herbs, grass, yellow plum, green pepper, and a zippy lemon acidity

**Dashwood Sauvignon Blanc 2016**

*Marlborough, New Zealand, 13%*

Brimming with zesty grapefruit, lime, pear and passion fruit married well with a herbaceous grassiness

**Malbrontes Torrontés 2015**

*Mendoza, Argentina, 13.5%*

Shows the typical floral and spice profile that has made Torrontés fashionable recently. Unoaked, weighty on the palate, delicate and subtle flavours accrued from the grapes' long hang-time on the vines

**Pulpo, Albariño Rías Baixas, Pagos del Rey 2015**

*Rías Baixas, Spain, 12.5%*

Unoaked, bright, pale lemon colour. Aromas of white flowers, peach and apricot lead to a fresh, fruity palate

**Sancerre, Domaine des Chaintres, Joseph Mellot 2015**, *Loire Valley, France, 13.5%*

Aromatic floral aromas of white blossom and grapefruit on the nose; the palate is refreshing and dry

### Rich, fruity wines

**Cullinan View Chenin Blanc 2016**

*Western Cape, South Africa, 12%*

South Africa's most popular grape variety. Youthful, fruity character and a fresh, zesty acidity. Very well-balanced, deliciously fresh and creamy with peachy fruit character

**Between Thorns Chardonnay 2016**

*South Eastern Australia, 13%*

A crisp, fruity Chardonnay with tropical aromas, followed by flavours of juicy nectarines and peaches and a hint of vanilla

**The Federalist Chardonnay 2015**

*Sonoma Country, California, 14.5%*

A rich, golden colour, the wine offers up ripe fruit reminiscent of lemon curd and pear on the nose; the palate has a lush texture and long, smooth finish punctuated with cinnamon and cardamom spice

### Soft, easy drinking wines

#### **Borsari Cabernet Sauvignon, Terre Siciliane**

**2015**, (House wine) *Campania, Italy, 11.5%*

Soft and juicy Cabernet Sauvignon, with ripe brambly fruit **4.00 / 5.40 / 15.95**

#### **Los Romeros Merlot 2016**

*Central Valley, Chile, 13%*

This wine is soft, juicy and shows spiced plum and dark berry fruit; it has a velvety outlook and is quite light-bodied **4.25 / 5.75 / 16.95**

#### **Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir 2015**

*Bordeaux, France, 13%*

The smooth, velvety palate shows cherry and blueberry flavours backed with a hint of sweet oak **19.95**

#### **Chapel Down Union Red 2014**

*Kent, England, 12%*

A blend of Rondo and Pinot Noir; Rondo is an unusual early ripening red variety which thrives in England's cooler climate. Its union with the classic Pinot Noir grape produces attractive cherry and strawberry flavours in a light refreshing red **29.95**

### Rich, fruity wines

#### **Square Ranch Malbec 2016**

*Mendoza, Argentina, 13%*

An abundance of bramble fruit and ripe dark plum, lightly spiced **4.75 / 6.50 / 18.95**

#### **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Parini 2015**

*Abruzzo, Italy, 12.5%*

Ruby-red, the nose shows plum and cherry with notes of violet; dry, soft but well-structured with a pleasant long lasting finish of dried fruits and toasted hazelnut **4.50 / 6.00 / 17.95**

### Dry, oaky wines

#### **Marqués de Morano Rioja Crianza 2014**

*Rioja, Spain, 12.5%*

Mazuelo adds a ripe cherry chunkiness to the smooth raspberries and cream style of Tempranillo **5.00 / 6.75 / 19.95**

#### **Rioja Gran Reserva, Marqués de Cáceres 2009**

*Rioja, Spain, 14%*

Blackcurrant and black cherry with notes of cream and vanilla spice; has a smooth, extended finish **39.95**

### Powerful, full-bodied wines

#### **Between Thorns Shiraz 2016**

*South Eastern Australia, 13%*

Cherry and raspberry, complemented by hints of spice and vanilla **4.50 / 6.00 / 17.95**

#### **Luis Felipe Edwards Gran Reserva Cabernet**

**Sauvignon 2015**, *Colchagua Valley, Chile, 14%*

Exceptional example of Chilean Cabernet with bags of bright cherry fruit, mint, eucalyptus and smoky vanilla oak **22.95**

#### **The Federalist 1776 Zinfandel 2014**

*Lodi, California, 15%*

A blend of 93% Zinfandel and 7% Syrah, this exceptional wine is dominated by flavours of plum and cherry, backed up by cinnamon spice; full-bodied, with a long smooth finish **36.95**

#### **Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Bois de Pied Redal, Organic, Ogier 2015**

*Rhône Valley, France, 14.5%*

The vineyard is certified organic. The blend is mainly Grenache, with Syrah, Mourvèdre and Cinsault. Dominated by black cherry and blackcurrant, spiced with liquorice and aromatic herbs; the palate is full-bodied with fine-grained tannins which give it a smooth finish **39.95**
